" Appoint watchmen [to guard] your city all day and all night."

We have been helping local farm owners by guarding their property at night. One night a week, volunteers from the Yeshiva patrol nearby fields, acting as a deterrent against unwanted visitors and enabling the farmers to sleep peacefully at night. Rav Chaim Baruch, Rosh Yeshiva

Rav Chaim Baruch:

Rabbi Hosha'ya said: When Israel arrives at (i.e., determines the time for) Rosh HaShana, HaKadosh Baruch Hu (HKBH) says to his ministering angels: Raise up the tribunal, and bring out the books.

Then they say: Why? And he says: Because I wish to judge my children tomorrow when it is Rosh HaShana.

They immediately raise up a tribunal and bring out the books. An earthly court has decided to proclaim a leap year; It says: tomorrow we are celebrating Rosh HaShana. The ministering angels say to HKBH: Master of the Universe, you did not tell us that tomorrow is Rosh HaShana.

He said to them: The reckoning is in their hands, as stated (in Exodus 12:2): "This new moon (i.e. this new month) shall be to you"; it is transferred to you. As for you and me, let us go to my children, so that whatever they do, we may go along with them.

Moses said (in Deuteronomy 4:7): "For what great nation is there that has G-d so near to it, as the Lord our G-d is at all times that we proclaim upon Him?"

Now the word "proclaim" is only used in reference to festival times. Thus it is stated (in Leviticus 23:4): "These are the Lord's appointed holy occasions, which you shall proclaim at their appointed time". Therefore (according to Exodus 12:2): "This new moon (i.e. this month)" belongs to you.

Midrash Tanchuma (Buber), Parashat Bo, Siman 3

Our Sages describe how the entire world is subject to human determination. Hashem created His world. But he leaves to Am Yisrael, His people, the ability to determine the essence of that world. Even the day of man's judgement and its consequences are dependent on him, on his decision on when to proclaim that day.

We learn from this about the work we have to do in our world, the partnership that Hashem is requesting of us. We should not wander the world as guests, and certainly not as those in charge, but rather as partners who carry great responsibility.

At the beginning of the year, at the special moment when justice appears in this world, when the Divine order appears, we enter the tribunal. And our judgement and the judgement of this world are passed.

With the incoming new year, I, as a representative of the entire Yeshiva team, would like to wish you a Shanah Tovah, a Happy New Year, a year of the fulfillment of all blessings. May the blessing of Hashem that appears in our redemption continue to flow from the individual to the collective, as full partners in the Creator's world.


